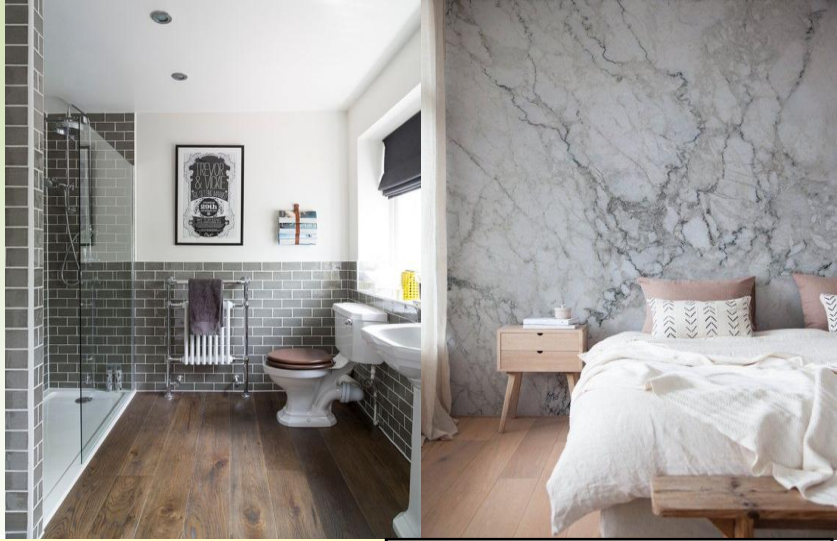


In: Wood Tile

The perfect sweet treat for fall! It's that time of year where pumpkin is found in all your favorite foods and snacks, so why not make it into a delicious and decadent donut?

Pumpkin Cake Donuts

Ingredients:

1/2 cup vegetable oil
3 large eggs
1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
1 15 oz. can pumpkin
1 1/2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
1 3/4 cups + 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour

Coating:

1 stick melted butter
1 cup granulated sugar
2 tablespoons cinnamon

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray donut pans with non-stick cooking spray.
2. In a large bowl add all ingredients through the baking powder, beat with mixer on medium speed until smooth. Add the flour stirring until smooth.
3. Fill the wells of the donut pans about 3/4 full. Bake donuts 15 to 18 minutes.
4. Remove donuts from the oven, after about 5 minutes, loosen their edges, and transfer them to a rack to cool. Then drizzle on the sugar cinnamon coating.
